

Re-organizational City Council Meeting
Hebron Community Center
June 26, 2018, 7:00 p.m.

Members present at the meeting were; Mayor Grant Walth, Council members; Chester Brandt, Harvey Tibor, Jim Staiger, Steve Dittus and Ken Rehling. Also present at the meeting; newly elected officials Pat Mischel and Ray Torres, Jane Brandt of the Hebron Herald, and Auditor Erin Brink. Not present was Councilman Michael Coots.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

Newly elected officials took the oath of office. Grant Walth read the oath for the position of Mayor, Ray Torres read the oath for the two year unexpired term, Chester Brandt read the oath for the four year term, Pat Mischel read the oath for the four year term, and Steve Dittus read the oath for the four year term.

The reorganization of the portfolios was discussed. Council decided to replace the outgoing council members with the newly elected officials in the portfolios.

A motion was made to elect Harvey Tibor as Council President. Brandt/Dittus MCU

A motion was made to elect Chester Brandt as Council Vice President. Dittus/Torres MCU

City Attorney Solem had contacted the Auditor concerning the out of town liquor establishment setting up at the benefit on July 7th. The recommendation made by Solem was to allow the establishment to receive a temporary city license to then make the liquor transfer for the benefit. A motion was made to approve the temporary license and transfer for the benefit. Tibor/Mischel MCU.
